3. Applicant demonstrates a strong effort to pursue other sources of funding for his/her education. (0-10)

BENEFITS: TWENTY (20) POINTS

1. Applicant clearly explains how the scholarship will contribute toward the completion of degree sought and why is it significant for the applicant's education. (0-20)

COMPOSITION: TWENTY (20) POINTS

1. Proposal is well written and free of grammatical errors. (0-10)
2. Proposal flows logically. Writing style is direct, formal, and descriptive. (0-10)

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION: TWENTY (20) POINTS

1. Letter demonstrates that applicant is within 3 semesters of graduating (including summer semester), is in good academic standing, and supports applicant's statement of financial need. (0 OR 20)
